You definitely know some of them, Grüner Veltliners, Blaufränkisch or even Welsch Rieslings but are they any different in Czechia? Come to the booth and meet local Pálava (white and aromatic) or St. Laurents (light and fruity red), they are quite unique to our region.

THE INTERNATIONALS

You can find them in many places in the world, those with Czech roots are solid in acidity, spiciness and pleasant fruitiness, taste some great Rieslings, Sauvignons Chardonnays, Pinots Blanc and Noir too.

In the HALL 4 look for the CIRCLES designed for us by CHYBIK + KRISTOF ASSOCIATED ARCHITECTS. Czech booth (A20) is talking to each visitor by circles and rounded shapes so typical for winemaking. Every morning and afternoon you can meet a different group of winemakers.

The representation is unbelievably colourful: meet micro winemakers beside the representants of some biggest companies in the country.

You will find the winners and finalists of various major competitions in Czechia (Winery and Winemaker of the year, Czech National competition etc.) as well as successful exporters around the globe. Czech wine has already found its fans in many different countries from Japan, through the UK and Sweden over to the US and Canada.

Moravian and Bohemian white wines are characterized by their fascinating spectrum of aromas, rich extractive substances and harmonious combination of full-bodied flavours along with fresh, vibrant acidity. Rosé wines are also keeping the trend. Beautiful not only for their colour but also for their exceptional youthful character.

ABOUT:

Gurdau winery was founded in 2012 by Zdeněk Hort in small village Kurdějov, historically one of the most important wine-growing villages in Moravia. The village, by its former German name Gurdau, is located near Hustopeče in wine region Velkopavlovicko, in a deep valley surrounded by the Žďánice Hills, a location ensuring unique terroir and closed microclimate, highly sloping tracks and great exposure.

Gurdau winery currently manage 10.5 hectares of vineyards, for all their tracks are typical calcareous sandstones covered with calcareous loess. Gurdau winery is mainly focused on the noble variety Riesling, which they have planted in 6 clones originated from the Wachau, Alsace, Rheingau and the Pfalz. From this single variety they produce the basic line, wines aged in oak barrels, sparkling wines and also sweet wines. To diversify the offer, Gurdau added two more varieties - Green Veltliner and Pinot Blanc. The wines are produced using gentle methods, with respect for nature and terroir.

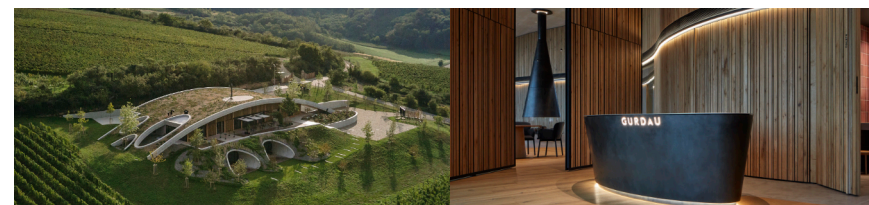

ABOUT:

Lahofer winery is one of the largest grape growers in the Czech Republic cultivating 430 hectares of land in the wine region Znojemsko.

Lahofer produces all wines of all major Central European varieties exclusively from grapes from its own vineyards (except for a special line of French wines). The range of their production methods is also very diverse – from the current modern technology of controlled fermentation in stainless steel tanks, to ageing in concrete tanks or in traditional oak barrels from France and acacia barrels from Croatia, to a return to historic production methods such as wines born in traditional Georgian earthenware kevekri.

Lahofer winery continuously obtains awards at international competitions such as Concours Mondial Bruxelles (2020-gold), AWC Vienna (2020-gold, silver, 2019-silver, 2018-gold), Decanter (2020-silver, bronze), Galicja Vitis (2019-gold), Finger Lakes IWC (2018-double gold), San Francisco IWC, Le Mondial du Rosé and at national competitions such as Winery of the year (winner 2020, 2021), King of wine (2016,2014), Wine Salon.

Obelisk Winery is housed in a modern building in the middle of the vineyards in Valtice, wine region Mikulovsko. The vineyards characterized by loess-loam soils rich in calcium are treated in the most ecological way and the grapes are harvested only by hand. The wines are characterized by postmodern wine-growing, where the winemaker pays close attention to their own specific development and limits unnatural impact into the character of the wine. The wines are made using old traditional techniques with the assistance of the modern technology which helps to achieve the originality and preserves the uniqueness of the terroir. The wines are aged in stainless steel tanks as well as in wooden barrels and amphorae made from clay.

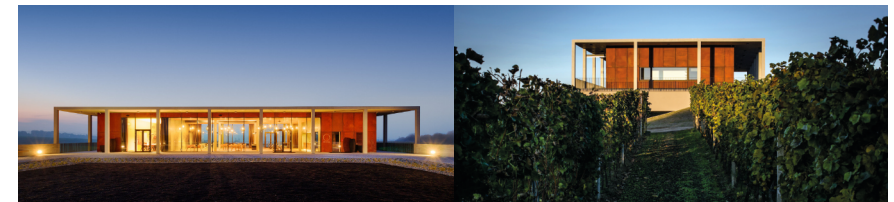

Piálek & Jäger

"We don't rush our wines"



ABOUT:

Piálek & Jäger is a winery built on the friendship between two families that continues the families' wine-making tradition since the 1950s. The vineyards are stretched out in the wine region Znojemsko, in the south of Moravia, close to the Austrian border, famous for aromatic wines. All grapes from Piálek & Jäger's vineyards on Cow Hill (Kraví hora) and Načeratice Hill are cultivated in organic standards and share the common trait of a rather intense flavorfulness. The natural (sandy soils with a moderately gravelly structure on old magmatic rocks, granite, gneiss, and granodiorites) and climatic conditions conspire to give the wine unmistakable zest, full-bodiedness, and minerality. At the center of the interest are varieties typical for Znojemsko: Grüner Veltliner, Sauvignon, and Riesling.

Piálek & Jäger's production is limited to bottled wine with special designations ("Prädikatsweine") in unique small, one-of-a-kind batches of around 3 000 bottles, giving the overall annual production of 50 000 bottles.

ABOUT:

The winery was founded in 1994 by Stanislav Popela in the village of Perná. The winery cultivates over 24 hectares of its own vineyards in the municipalities of Perná and Bavorský in the wine region Mikulovsko and strives to intensively use this unique terroir. The slopes on which their vineyards are located are mainly characterised by their calcareous subsoil with a high proportion of mineral substances. The local climatic conditions, the location of the vineyards and the soil composition are considered to be the best in South Moravia.

The winery produces varietal, quality, predicated and special wines typical for the Mikulov wine region. Further part of the production includes cuvée and frizzante wines.

Popela Perná winery obtains awards at international competitions such as Concours Mondial Bruxelles (2020-silver), Great American IWC (2021-silver), AWC Vienna (2021-gold, silver), Decanter (2022-silver, bronze), Prague Wine Trophy (2022-gold).

ABOUT:

Sonberk - the only two-time holder for the absolute winner of Winery of the Year in the Czech Republic. The iconic view of the Pálava landscape area, spectacular architecture, and characteristic wines appreciated over the world are the main features of the winery. A place where winemaking is managed according to the rules of sustainable Production. Vineyards spread over about 45 hectares of loess soil with an average yield of around 1.5 kg of grapes per vine. The grapes are harvested entirely by hand and processed as gently as possible using gravity technology. Result is 50 to 150 thousand bottles of wine.

Sonberk's most popular varieties Riesling and Pálava garner positive acclaim from both domestic and international evaluators; so not only are they found in several Michelin star restaurants over the world, but they also boast titles such as the Best Dry White Wine of Central and Eastern Europe and the Best Dry Aromatic White Wine in the World according to the Decanter World Wine Awards. Also, the naturally sweet straw wine is pressed by winemaker Mr. Drápal - notably the first straw wine producer in the Czech Republic. Mentions of Sonberk's wine can be found in the Financial Times, New York Times, Wall Street Journal, and Le Figaro. Sonberk wines are also on display at La Cité du Vin in Bordeaux.

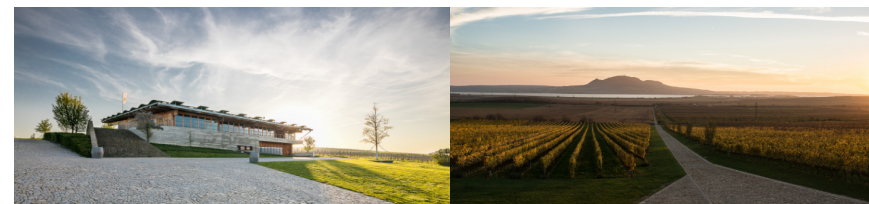

THAYA vineyards are located in the wine region Znojemsko, a region typical for its full-flavoured and fresh wines. It is the River Dyje or Thaya, which, through its thermoregulatory influence, together with the cold winds from the Bohemian-Moravian Highlands, gives the local wines their unmistakable spicy taste and fullness. Thanks to the granitic subsoil and the loess with a mixture of calcareous clays, the Veltliner, Sauvignon and Riesling are particularly outstanding.

THAYA farms about 105 hectares of own vineyards located in the immediate vicinity of the winery and in the neighbouring wine-growing villages. The vineyards adjacent to the Podyjí National Park have been known since the ancient Romans for their unique sunny location.

THAYA winery is repeated finalist in competitions such as Winery of the Year and Winemaker of the Year, THAYA wines are also regularly successful in international competitions, and with each harvest the winery moves forward.

Válka winery is family-run organic winery founded in 1991 and based on family traditions and a natural approach to growing grapes. The winery takes care of more than 11 hectares of vineyards in the beautiful natural park of Výhon in wine region Velkopavlovicko.

Many years ago, Válka winery chose the path of organic winemaking, where the intention is ideally not to interfere with the wine. No yeasts, hand harvesting, spontaneous fermentation, minimum sulphur, this is the standard. Válka produce wines in a natural and ecological style with minimal use of sulfites and using the most gentle production methods.

Válka winery obtains awards at international competitions such as Berliner Wine Trophy, Galicja Vitis, AWC Vienna, IWC Cuvée2020, Grand Prix Vinex.

All wines from Winery Mikrosvín Mikulov are made exclusively from its own raw material, which is harvested on 12 vineyard lines in the wine region Mikulovsko. The absolute top among the vineyards are the tracks Železná, Goldhamer, and Purmice.

The calcium rich soil in the Mikulov region give the wines a unique character of great spiciness and density by limiting the growth of the vines and concentrating their quality. The premium grape variety here is Welschriesling, alongside Grüner Veltliner, Riesling and Chardonnay. In recent years, new local varieties such as Pálava have been successful.

Winery Mikrosvín's philosophy of vine cultivation is based on a low load on the bushes, a gentle approach with a maximum limitation of chemical inputs. All the grape material is gently harvested at the appropriate time, the best grapes are harvested by hand. The grapes are then processed with the utmost care, production is based on the gravity approach. For the production of their wines, the special approach of the people is extremely important.

The family winery, whose roots date back to 1945, entered the wine market under the name Vinařství Volařík in 2007. In integrated production it now manages 80 ha of integrated production vineyards in the wine region Mikulovsko, of which 4.2 ha are in organic production. The grapes are harvested mainly by hand. The winery focuses on the production of predicate wines, especially white wines, the offer is complemented by rosé, red wines and Volařík Sekt produced using the traditional method.

The winery creates its own range of TERROIR wines – a combination of the most prestigious vineyards with the most suitable grape variety. While producing the terroir wine, special care is taken to bring out the uniqueness of the vineyard in which the vines grow. The must is fermented with a wild yeast culture and no fining agents are used during fermentation and subsequent ageing. The doses of sulphur dioxide are kept to a minimum and only coarse diatomaceous earth filtration is carried out before bottling. The resulting wines then offer a unique symphony of colour, aroma and flavour and are destined to develop for a long time in bottle.
